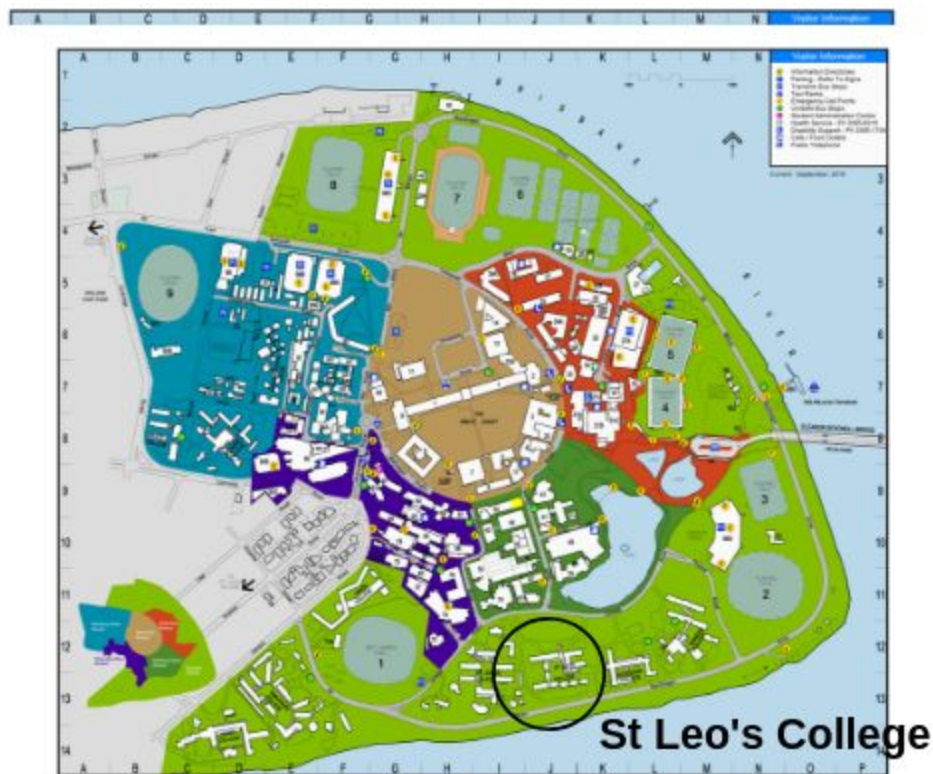




BAM General Information
